Bucuti & Tara, holding the most eco-certifications and the <u>Caribbean's first and only certified</u> <u>carbon-neutral hotel</u> combined with being <u>Tripadvisor's No. 21 Best Hotel in the World</u>, made for a natural choice for Bonaire tourism authorities as they strive to deliver a responsible travel experience.

Biemans' keynote presentation, titled *Achieving Hospitality Excellence: The Bucuti & Tara Journey*, chronicled the evolution of the resort from its inception in 1987 to its current standing as a world leader in sustainable tourism. Known for spearheading Aruba's sole adults-only resort, Biemans provided an inside look at Bucuti & Tara's strategic focus that cares for both people and place without sacrificing one or the other.

Highlights of the presentation included:

- **Turning challenges into opportunities**. From opening the resort on "Black Monday" during the 1987 stock market crash to innovating energy-saving programs in the 1990s amidst soaring oil prices, Biemans demonstrated how Bucuti & Tara embraces adversity and turns it into success.
- *Market specialization*. Biemans' strategy of catering to a niche market of honeymooners and couples, while others sought mass-market appeal, has helped solidify the resort's place as a leader in romantic getaways, wellness and regenerative travel. The resort's popular "What We Are Not" list further supports its bold approach of not needing to be everything to everyone, an approach Biemans encouraged summit attendees to consider.
- **Sustainability leadership**. Bucuti & Tara's sustainability journey, from becoming the first Green Globe-certified hotel in the Caribbean to the integration of solar panels, water-saving initiatives, and waste diversion programs including partnerships, shows that luxury and sustainability can coexist. Biemans also highlighted the resort's next big goal of reaching Net Zero emissions, which will be achieved in the coming months.
- **Community and stewardship**. From supporting local conservation efforts like <u>Stimami Sterilisami</u>, the resort-founded spay/neuter program curbing Aruba's pet overpopulation issue, to founding

Aruba's litter clean-ups and gifting the island with <u>The Bucuti Tara - GMC Nature Preserve</u>, Biemans shared how Bucuti & Tara's environmental and social commitment stretches beyond resort grounds.

The Annual Bonaire Tourism Summit is a key event in Bonaire's celebration of World Tourism Day. With the goal of enhancing sustainable tourism, the summit brought together tourism experts to share knowledge, best practices, and innovative solutions. As a recognized trailblazer in environmental conservation, Biemans' insights inspired the tourism industry to prioritize both business excellence and environmental stewardship.
