Free Access to Spay & Neuter Services

Instituted on Aug. 20, 2025, pet owners and rescue foundations can register for the free sterilization procedures through <u>StimamiSterilisami.com</u>. After registering, participants will receive a confirmation number to present at participating veterinary clinics, including:

- VSH Veterinary Specialty Hospital
- Caduary Veterinary Clinic

Why Spaying and Neutering Matters

Aruba faces one of the highest stray animal densities in the Caribbean, a challenge that affects animal

welfare, community health and the island's tourism image. Unchecked reproduction results in thousands of unwanted litters that strain shelters and public resources.

- A single unspayed dog and her offspring can produce up to 67,000 puppies in six years.
- A cat and her descendants can produce over 11 million kittens in the same timeframe.

Sterilization is the most effective and humane solution, preventing suffering before it starts, while delivering direct benefits for pets and families, including:

- Lower risk of cancers and infections
- Reduced behavioral issues
- Safer neighborhoods and fewer animal-related accidents
- Cleaner, more welcoming communities for residents and island visitors alike

Since its founding, Stimami Sterilisami has subsidized more than 41,000 sterilization procedures, dramatically reducing Aruba's stray population and preventing countless litters.

Uniting for Compassion through Community Effort

Stimami Sterilisami was founded by Bucuti & Tara Beach Resort in 2016 to create a lasting, humane solution to Aruba's stray animal crisis. Today, Bucuti & Tara remains the foundation's largest donor, contributing Afl. 400,000 in 2025 alone to ensure sterilization is free for all pet owners and rescue organizations.
